We noted with interest the joint industry submission on January 30, 2004, to this docket from the American Herbal Products Association, the Council for Responsible Nutrition, and the National Nutritional Foods Association. While those associations, like our own, submitted comments on FDA's proposed rule for dietary supplement Good Manufacturing Practices in August 2003, they continued to work on specific language for the GMP rule that would both resolve concerns for the industry and assist the agency in its preparation of a rigorous but reasonable final rule.

We would like to add our voice to theirs in supporting the joint industry submission. We urge FDA to strongly consider the joint comments as the agency develops a final rule for dietary supplement GMPs.
